This brick church is dated 1890. It is painted red and built with an all stretcher surface. Decorative corbeling trims the doors, windows, and eaves forming a contrasting affect with light and shadow. Windows and doors have a gothic pointed arched tops. The main entrance is in a square projecting tower with a pointed steeple. A modern addition is attached to one end of the building.




