DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two part house consists of a two story three bay balloon frame section dating from the early 20th century. To its rear is a smaller one and a half story, two bay log extension with an exterior chimney of brick. Interior and exterior woodwork and trim of both sections is typical of the turn of the century period.




