DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Stouffer's Mennonite Church is a one story five bay structure built of brick in common bond and painted white. Two 20th century additions, one in 1950 and one in 1976 were attached to the rear of the building. Windows and doors of the older part of the building have segmentally arched tops. A tablet in the gables indicates that the church was built in 1828 and rebuilt 1895. No physical evidence of the 1828 structure remains at the exterior of the building.




