DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This farm complex consists of a German sided log house, a frame bank barn and frame and log outbuildings. The house is a two story, five bay log structure said to be dated 1781. Nine over six pane windows are present at the first story while some six over six sashes remain at the second story level. Interior wood work was not observed. Apparently the siding, present roof and eaves construction and porch date from the early 20th century


