DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This farmstead includes a two story early 20th century brick house and a frame bank barn. The house is painted red and features some windows with multi-paned transoms and a pair of dormers with pedimented gabled roofs and multi-paned upper sashes. Wrapping around much of the house is a one story porch supported by square posts and with a central pedimented gable. Several six over six windows suggest that portions of the house might actually have been built before the 20th century. A large frame bank barn is also present.


