DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This farmhouse is a two story, five bay structure with a recessed double porch along part of the front elevation. It is built with common bonding at the side and rear walls and in the recessed area of the front elevation. The main part of the front wall displays Flemish bonding. All windows have six over six pane sashes and three light transoms are present above the doors. Victorian turned posts support the double porch. The house has a slate roof which is probably a replacement. Also on the property is a frame bank barn and a number of other agricultural buildings.




