DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This stone cabin was built directly over a spring of water. When photographed in November of 1976, it stood in near ruin. Since that time it has been destroyed. It was built of roughly coursed local limestone with large stones used to form the corners. Where window and door frames could be seen, they were narrow. A 20th century brick chimney was built against an end wall. The building had most recently been used as a stable.
