DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This farmstead includes an aluminum sided two story house, a large frame bank barn with decorative metal ventilator cupolas and numerous agricultural and domestic outbuildings. The house is a two story, three bay structure with a central chimney. Beneath the aluminum siding may be a log structure as suggested by deep door and windows jambs. A double porch included under the main roof span extends across the front elevation. Windows appear relatively small, but all have had their sashes replaced with 20th century single panes.


