DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This farmstead consists of a two story, five bay brick cased log house with a double porch along the entire front elevation, a stone end bank barn with a frame gable, a frame shop with board and batten siding, a wagon shed and other outbuildings. Windows in the house have been replaced and most exterior surfaces have relatively modern treatment. Some interior woodwork suggests the early 19th century while other elements are typical of later 19th century and early 20th century work. The house would appear to have been built in at least two sections.


