DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This small farmstead is located on a property which is an apple orchard. The house is a two story, three bay brick structure with common bonding used at all elevations. Windows have six over six pane sashes. The house displays exterior construction techniques which would associate it with a building date during the third quarter of the 19th century. A frame barn is an early 20th century building.


