25 West Water Street is a north-facing, horizontally massed, symmetrical, two-and-a-half story, five-bay, freestanding, frame residential structure resting on a stone foundation. It has a small, square, projecting bay on its west facade. The building is sited at the top of a steep slope, overlooking the street. It is one of three almost matching frame structures in a row. A similar brick structure is located next to this row.

The side gable roof, which is covered with grey slate, holds a minor cross gable in the center bay. The front gable has a bargeboard with a sunburst motif popular during the Arts and Crafts movement. The side gables have fish-scale, diamond-shaped, and staggered wood shingles that match those found in the gable ends of 20 West Water Street. The fenestration consists of single, rectangular, wooden sash, double-hung, Queen Anne multipane-over-one windows with shutters. The front facade windows on the first floor extend to the floor. The entrance is approached from a set of stairs at the center of the facade, leading up to a raised open, eastlake porch covered by a hipped roof and supported by squared, ornamental posts. A modern wrought-iron railing has been added between the posts. The entrance surround is a simplified version of that found on 23 West Water.

The building has received a small one-story addition on the rear and has a board and batten garage in its rear yard.

The house is set on original lot 28, a vacant lot that was owned by George Webb, according to the 1814 plat of the town. No

— building appears on the site, then owned by B.C. Bishop, on the 1875 map either. According to the Smithsburg Historical Society, the neighboring matching house (#23) was built in 1904. It is likely that this building was constructed at approximately the same time. It appears on the 1916 and 1923 Sanborns as 32 Water Street.

The building is within the Western Maryland Geographic Organization, the Development Period of Industrial/Urban Dominance, and falls within the Historic Period Theme of Architecture, Landscape Architecture and Community Planning.
