BUILDING DATE: early 20th century?

This is a greatly altered two-story, three-bay, freestanding, frame residence. The building is covered with manufactured siding. The side gable is sheathed with artificial roll. A shed-roof awning protects the front door and western bay window. This window has been shortened and widened and accommodates a single pane of glass. Original windows in the house are wooden sash, double-hung, two-over-two panes. The chimney is built of cinder block. There appears to be a large rear addition which altered the original roofline.

The property is located outside the original town limits, but within the limits indicated on the 1875 map. The vacant property was owned at that time by B.C. Bishop.

The building is within the Western Maryland Geographic Organization, the Development Period of Industrial/Urban Dominance, and falls within the Historic Period Theme of Architecture, Landscape Architecture and Community Planning.
