DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This stone farmhouse is a two and a half story, four bay structure, facing south. Extending to the rear or north is a one and a half story ell. Masonry of the front elevation is unusually fine among rural farmhouses. Stones are laid in regular courses following a Flemish Bond motif. High in the gable is a round opening lined with bricks. Flat arches of angle cut stones are present above the windows and doors. All windows have massive frames trimmed with ovolo molding. Upper story windows have six over six light sashes while those below have nine over six sashes. Most have Victorian louvered shutters.

A spring emerges at the back of the house. Ruins of a large stone secondary building are located adjacent to it.

A bank barn and other agricultural buildings are also part of the complex.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This farmhouse is worthy of further study. The expert masonry associated with its front elevation is particularly worthy of note. The exterior architectural evidence suggests that the house was built during the 1790-1810 period. The other stone building beside it remains a mystery.
