DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house is a two story, three bay log structure sheathed with German siding. The walls of the building are high with windows spaced some distance apart. Most have six over six pane sashes. The east end bay of the front or south elevation has openings at the first and second story levels with lower lintels than the other windows and doors. Entrances are located in the center and east end bays of the front elevation. Most windows have six over six sashes. According to the owner of the property, the house was much longer at one time, and a section of the structure was removed earlier in this century. Datable material at the exterior of the house is typical of the early 20th century. However, the general form and proportion of the house could suggest 18th century construction. A frame bank barn is also present.
