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DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Some controversy has developed as to the exact location of the 18th century Conococheague Church, known today as St. Paul's Lutheran Church. The site of the church, established in 1747, is generally believed to be a short distance west of present Ridge Road near Meadow Brook. The site included a church and a stockade. In the 1790's it was replaced by a larger structure at the present site of St. Paul's Church. The vicinity of the original location has been disturbed by the course of I-70 and most recent research indicates that the site of the church might either be on the median strip of beneath the west bound lane of the interstate highway. Possible evidence of ruts from an old road were seen on the median strip.

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STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Conococheague Church, one of the earliest in the Washington County area was established prior to the French and Indian War. The congregation later moved to a site closer to Clear Spring. Older residents of the area have conflicting opinions concerning remembered references to the location of the church. The Conococheague Church is important as contributing to early settlement in Washington County.




