DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house is a two story, three bay brick building with a one story, two bay brick extension at one end which appears contemporary with the main section. The entire structure was painted yellow and common bonding was used at all elevations. Wide lintels have been painted white above the openings. A course of alternating projecting bricks at the eaves forms a cornice. First story front windows appear to have been enlarged and have large single pane sashes. Other windows have six over six pane sashes.

A frame barn is also present.





