DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This farmhouse is a two story, three bay structure with a one story, two bay wing extending to the rear. Walls are constructed of coursed limestone in relatively large uniform blocks at the front elevation with more random masonry in evidence at the side and rear walls. Some openings are topped with wedge shaped rocks resembling keystones. The main door is located at one end of the front wall, giving the house a side hall entrance. The interior of the house has been gutted. The type of masonry displayed as well as remaining exterior woodwork suggest that this house was built during the second quarter of the 19th century. A barn was located on the opposite side of the Licking Creek Road from the house.




