DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This brick farmhouse is a two story, three bay L-shaped structure with a three bay wing extending to the rear. The wing had a recessed double porch along its west wall which has since been enclosed. The house is constructed with all stretcher bricks at the front elevation and common bonding at the side and rear walls. In the west gable is a date tablet inscribed J.T. Mason, 1848.

Windows have six over six pane sashes including those at the attic level of the main section. The principal entrance is located at the west end of the front or south elevation. It includes a broad transom and side-lights around the door. Muntin bars form a diamond pattern of glazir. Double chimneys are located inside the end walls of the main section. The cornice is finished with courses of brick corbeling, the bottom row being an alternating series of projecting bricks resembling dentils.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This house provides a dated example of period brick rural architecture. Its builder, John Thompson Mason was a prominent local man. He came from a wealthy Southern Maryland family that settled along the Licking Creek during the early 19th century.


