DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Ruins of this log cabin are now used as a cattle barn. It was a one and a half story, two bay structure with a one story, one bay log addition. Corner joints display "V" notching.

Southwest of the house over a small run which empties into the Conococheague Creek are ruins of an old stone arched culvert. It would appear that the road once passed slightly to the south of its present alignment with this culvert carrying it across the run. A slight depression in the topography suggests the road's course.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The age of these vernacular structures cannot be determined from information available at present. The log house follows a typical cabin form and the culvert was built in the manner of other such structures found in the County. Most of the stone bridges and culverts date between 1820 and 1860.


