DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house is a two story six bay L-shaped structure completely sheathed with asbestos shingle siding. The two eastern bays of the front or south section would appear to be of balloon frame construction while the remainder of the house has the wide window and door jambs characteristic of log construction. Exterior finishes of the house date from the 20th century making an assessment of its actual age difficult.

East of the house is a large frame bank barn with decorative metal ventilators on its roof ridge. A frame domestic outbuilding has a large stone and brick exterior chimney.


