DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This log farmhouse which faces east was built in two parts. Although it was probably sided originally, the log structure of the building has now been exposed revealing a two story, two bay house to which a narrower two story, two bay building has been added. The original section forms the south wing of the house and the addition is to its north end wall, as evidenced by the placement of the addition post. The corners display V notching.

Chimneys are located inside each end with brick fireplace backs exposed in the exterior end walls.

Interior woodwork in the older section is of a type associated with the 1840's period.

Behind the house is a large frame bank barn.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This 19th century farmhouse is a typical vernacular log dwelling. Unlike most log houses, this example is not sided and reveals its structure. The farm located with a bend of the Conococheague Creek is now reached by a private lane which approaches it from the west. Apparently it was originally approached from the east by a public road which forded the creek just south of the present alignment of I-70.


