DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The farmhouse on this property is a two and a half story four bay brick structure painted white, with Flemish bond at the front wall and common bond at the other elevations. Its high stone foundations add another story at the front. A triple decker porch extends across the entire front wall. Two front entrances are located side by side at the center of the front story. One door is located at the upper level porch. Nine over six pane sashes are used at the first story level windows while other windows have six over six pane sashes.

The house would appear to date from the second quarter of the 19th century.

Other buildings include a large frame bank barn, a wagon shed and other agricultural and domestic buildings.




