This farm lane is believed to be part of the route of an early road to the west known as the Allegany Road, or locally as the Williamsport-Green Spring Furnace Road. There is no way of substantiating this belief without further investigation. Like many older roads, it is bordered by fieldstone fences along some of its length.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Allegany Road was a major 18th century wagon road to the west. Locally, it led from Williamsport to the Green Spring Furnace both of which were established during the third quarter of the 18th century. If this private farm lane is part of the Allegany Road it would indeed be historically significant.


