DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The house in this complex is a two story five bay brick structure with the four southern most bays of its east elevation recessed beneath a double porch. Windows have six over six pane sashes hung beneath wide wooden lintels. Pairs of three panel shutters are used at the first story while louvered shutters are used at the second story level. The house has been painted white. A frame bank barn and a tile silo are located nearby.




