DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This farmstead includes a two part aluminum sided log and frame house. The original part of the house was a four bay, two story log section that now forms the east end of the structure. It was later enlarged with a two story frame addition. Some older windows remain at the second story of the log section. The entire surface of the rest of the house dates from the 20th century. It has been substantially altered.

Modern Dairy barns are also present.
