Since photographs were taken of this house in 1977, the entire second story has been removed and a new roof applied. The house as it appeared before the alterations was a two story, four bay structure with common bond at all elevations. It was an L-shaped structure with a wing extending to the rear. Windows had six over six pane sashes beneath flat arches of brick. The double eight panel front door was hung beneath a three light transom. A double brick chimney was located inside the north end wall.


