DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This small church, one bay wide and four bays long appears to be a frame structure completely sheathed with composition siding. All windows have pointed Gothic arch. The main facade in the north gable wall forms a parapet with crenelation. A round window is located in the top of the gable. Extending from the wall surface is the entrance bay, a gable roofed structure with a parapet following the lines of the main gable.

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
