Four Locks on the C & O Canal is a cluster of four stone locks, numbers 49-50. They are located at the point where the Canal cuts across a narrow peninsula of land known as The Neck, or Frather's Neck. The locks are constructed of uniform blocks of cut native stone resembling ashlar. This portion of the Canal does not contain water.
