Along U.S. Route 40 on Fairview Mountain are a group of stone cabins dating from the early 20th century. They are part of a former motel and date from the earlier part of the century. They are constructed of the native brown granular mountain stone, are one story in height and most have chimneys. The motel of which they are a part is no longer operating. Some cabins appear to have been made into small residences.
