DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The stone house on this farm is a two story, five bay structure of roughly coursed local stone. Its three northern most bays are recessed forming a two story porch which has been enclosed.

The windows are small wedge shaped blocks resembling keystones. Most windows have single pane double hung sashes. Those at the first story retain nine pane upper sashes.

Behind the house is a frame bank barn with decorative metal ventilators.


