DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This farmstead of frame buildings includes a two story three bay timber framed house. It is an L-shaped structure with a wing extending to the rear. It has a recessed double porch along its south elevation. The building is completely sheathed with wooden lapped siding. The siding runs in narrow uniform courses at the front elevation and is of random width at the side and rear walls. The construction of the main or front section includes no brick infill or nogging between the framing members. The back section does have nogging. All windows have narrow beaded frames and six over six pane sashes. The main entrance in the center bay of the front elevation has a broad transom and side lights around an eight panel door. The present Victorian porch replaced an older porch with a flat roof presumably more befitting of the Greek Revival influence upon this house. Part of an old wood shingle roof remains.

Attached to the back of the building is a one story out kitchen. Near by is a fraem bank barn. In front of the house is an old split rail fence.


