This farmstead is improved with a brick house, a brick out kitchen and a frame bank barn. The house is a two story, three bay painted brick structure with a gable front. Common bonding was used at all elevations. A Victorian porch spans the front elevation. Windows have six over six pane sashes.

Behind the house is the brick outkitchen from which extends a stone "beehive" oven.

According to the present owner, the house had a wing extending to its east which has been removed.




