DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This log house which appears to have been built in sections is a two story, four bay structure sheathed with asbestos shingle siding except at the front elevation which has wooden board siding. A stone exterior chimney which appears to have been extended in height is built against the south end wall east of the roof ridge. A two story porch extends across the entire front elevation. Windows and doors are sized and placed irregularly. Some have two over two pane sashes and have been elongated while others have six over six sashes.

A stone out kitchen is attached to the south end.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This log house is reputed to be an 18th century structure. It has been raised by a half story and widened considerably as well. Its age cannot be determined from exterior evidence. Most exterior finishes date from the second quarter of the 19th century or later. There is said to have been a black smith's shop on the property.
