DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house is a two story, three bay sandstone structure with a one story, two bay wing attached to its west end wall. The masonry is of rubble hammer faced stone. Wide wood lintels are present above the doors and windows. Windows have nine over six pane sashes at both the first and second story levels. The main entrance, in the central bay, has a door with two tiers of three vertical panels. Around the door is a broad transom and side lights with curved mantins. At the side of the front door are vertical fluted panels with decorated corner blocks at their tops.


