DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This farmstead includes a frame house and barn, both vacant. The house is a two story, seven bay structure with four northern bays of the front elevation recessed forming a double porch. Windows have two over two pane sashes, doors have four panels and two light transoms. The entire structure is sheathed with German siding.


