DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house is a two story, five bay stone structure with its wall displaying regular narrow courses of native limestone. First story front and end wall windows are topped with flat arches of angle cut stone. Extending to the rear is a one story stone wing which has been heightened with brick to one and a half stories. Window frames and sashes have been replaced. The main entrance, however, has a wide pegged frame and a four light transom. A one story porch with elaborate Victorian brackets has been attached to three bays of the front elevation. A frame outkitchen and smoke house are present and a frame bank barn.




