DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This farmhouse is a two story, five bay structure with German siding, and L-shaped, frame farm house dating from Ca. 1900. It has standard turn of the century architectural elements including singel pane window sashes, flat topped architraves, louvered shutters and a front porch with restrained gingerbread. The central entrance has a single pane transom. The only major alteration appears to have been the application of a modern asphalt roof.

This house is an example of a turn of the century farm dwelling. According to the present owner, it replaced an earlier structure that burned. The house follows the traditional five bay, central entrance plan which was popular in the area from the late 18th through the early 20th century.


