The Kaylor residence lies within the Fort Frederick State Park, a National Historic Landmark, off of Route 56 in Indian Springs, MD. It is a 2-1/2 story, 5 bay, double pile house with a tin roof and wooden weatherboard under the present brick-asbestos shingles. The house is a balloon frame building with a fieldstone foundation. The windows are 2 over 2 and retain their original wood frames. The porch has machine-sawn trim, chamfered square posts and a shed roof. The house is not individually eligible for the National Register, but because it is included within the Fort Frederick Park boundaries, it is a contributing element to the park under Criterion C as an example of rural Victorian architecture of the later 19th century.

Prepare both a one paragraph summary and a comprehensive description of the resource and its various elements as it exists today.

The Kaylor House is located within the boundaries of Fort Frederick State Park in Washington County, Maryland. The property is reached by a gravel road off of Maryland Route 56.

The essential characterization is a rural Victorian vernacular house constructed of balloon framing and resting on a fieldstone foundation. It is side gabled, two stories high with a vented attic, and five bays wide. There is asbestos siding in the design of brick, but the original siding was wood clapboard which is still located underneath the asbestos covering. The roof is a standing seam tin roof, with the edges extending beyond the end walls, and the barge boards and returns covered with molded trim. Two brick chimneys are located within the end walls of the roof. Windows, of which there are many, are 2/2 pane sash, with molding on the exterior casing and pointed top pieces. An elaborate porch design, with chamfered square posts and curvilinear brackets, is what really identifies this house as a Victorian. It is located in the central bay of the east elevation, has a standing seam tin roof, and a transom window over the paneled wood door.

The interior is a simple massed plan with rooms located on either side of a central hallway, and a two room kitchen to the rear of the house. A one story wood frame addition on a stone foundation has been added to the west end. The entire house has the typical wood detailing of rural Victorian houses in Maryland, with molded wood surrounds around the first and second floor windows and doors, and a turned post staircase in the central hallway.

There are numerous outbuildings on the property that are all constructed of wood, and do not appear to be historic.

The house is a two story, five bay balloon frame structure resting on ~~freed~~ ^{freed} stone foundations. Its walls have been covered with imitation brick composition siding. Windows have two over two pane sash with architraves having pointed top pieces with molded trim. The main entrance is in the central bay of the front elevation. Above the four ~~panel~~ ^{panel} door is a narrow single pane transom.

Across the three central bays of the front elevation at the first story is a shed roofed porch. It is supported by chamfered square posts with delicate curvilinear brackets.

The roof is sheathed with sheet metal and extends beyond the end walls with molded trim on the the barge boards and returns.

Chimneys are located a short distance inside the end walls.

The house appears to be in good condition. Frame sheds and domestic outbuildings are also part of the complex.


