DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Catalpa Chapel located at Cohill siding on the Western Maryland Railroad is a one and a half story, three bay frame structure with German siding. The building rests on new concrete block foundations which suggests that it may have been moved. Windows have pointed Gothic arches and a small entrance bay is centered in the front gable wall. Decorative shingle work has been applied in the front gable.

A small cemetery is located north of the church. It includes stones with the surnames Post, Younter, Peck, Norris and Corbett.


