This long narrow log house was built in two sections. The older section is the western three bays. An addition post indicates that the eastern two bays are newer. Most of the structure has been coated with stucco. The logs are revealed only where a front porch which extended across the front of the building was removed. The west end has an exterior stone chimney.

This house is part of an orchard complex although it appears to have been a farm formerly.


