This house is located along a long lane leading from Deneen Road in southwestern Washington County. It is a two story three bay log structure with its construction exposed. The house appears to have been extensively renovated and has received new chinking and daubing, gable siding and windows. The logs display square corner notching reinforced with large wire nails. Small brick chimneys are located inside the end walls.
