 DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house is a two story, three bay frame structure of late 19th century construction. The first story has a semi-hexagonal projecting bay and a store front and door in the north corner. The walls are sided with aluminum siding and the roof is covered with three tab grit shingles. Above the central door, the bay, and the north corner store door is a porch hip roof with late cast iron support posts. The windows are two over two double hung sash. There is one exterior gable chimney of recent construction.
