DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This brick house would appear to date from the mid-late 19th century. It stands on the west side of Conococheague Street, facing east. The structure is a two story, three bay residence with bricks laid in all stretcher bond at the front elevation. Other walls have common bond with a 5:1 stretcher to header row ratio.

Windows have single pane double hung sashes beneath wide wood lintels with molded trim. The main entrance is located at the south end bay and is treated similarly to the windows. A double inside end chimney of brick is located at the north wall.
