DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This structure is a two and one half story, four bay house, built of brick with a mansard roof. It is located on the west side of North Conococheague Street, facing east. The entire building has been painted dark grey.

Bricks forming the walls are laid in all stretcher bond at the front elevation.

Fenestration at the first story consists of a grouping of three two over two pane sash windows to form one large window. The off center entrance is located in the second bay from the north end of the house.

The upper panes of the two over two sashes have arched tops. The architraves consist of flat pieces with decorated corner blocks.

At the eaves is a deep frieze with decorative brackets, rectangular ventilators and applied trim. Projecting from the mansard roof are three gable roofed dormers.


