DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This residence, now forming part of a grocery store, is a two story, five bay brick structure standing on the west side of North Conococheague Street facing east. Painted white, its walls are laid in common bond with segmental arches over the openings. The two north bays at the first story display the remains of a turn of the century period store front. It has been replaced with a modern portion of the present market.

Most of the exterior accretions to this building date from the turn of the century period. However, there is some evidence such as the spacing of the fenestration and the parapet at the roof and an interior chimney that suggests that an older structure may have been reworked.

Windows have single pane double hung sashes. The main entrance is located in the center bay of the front elevation.

At the eaves is a series of decorative brackets.


