DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two story ten bay brick row house would appear to date from the late 19th century. It stands on the west side of North Conococheague Street and faces east. The row house is broken into five two bay residential units.

Windows have two over two pane or more recent single pane double hung sashes beneath segmentally arched heads. Entrances have similarly arched heads and single pane transoms. Original doors have five molded panels. The more northerly four bays are at a slightly lower level to accommodate the terrain, although the line of the eaves remains constant.

A heavy molded cornice with massive brackets marking the division between units crowns the building.


