This structure is a two story, frame, four bay, double house with an attic, and a fully exposed, brick faced foundation/basement to the front. The house has a standing seam tin roof, horizontal aluminum siding, two over two double hung sash and a window, door, door, window arrangement on the first story. There is a two bay front porch with a set of stairs at each end for entrance into each side of the house. The house was likely built in the latter half of the 19th century.


