DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house is a two story, with attic and basement, painted brick residence situated on the north side of West Potomac Street, facing south. It is of the Queen Anne Style, asymmetrical, and has a variety of roof shapes all slate covered, a projecting facade on the north side and a hexagonal tower on the south corner. The windows have brick segmental arched headers, and one over one double hung sashes. A low hip roof porch extends across most of the front. There is a decorative iron pineal on the point of the tower roof. It was built in the late 19th century.


