Situated on the north side of East Potomac Street and facing south is a two story house with an attic and basement, and a attached one car garage that has five bays with a central door. There is a standing seam tin roof, one over one double hung sash, a Flemish bond brick front with a water table, and a limestone foundation. This building has had some 20th century alterations to the windows, door entrance, porch and the garage was added, but it was originally built in the 18th century.




