 DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Situated on the north side of West Salisbury and facing south on the corner of Vermont Street is a two story, log, four bay store with second floor living quarters. It has a sheet metal roof, aluminum siding, and two over two double hung sash. The store front is entered from the east or Vermont Street side under a small hip roof porch. The exterior has had several changes to it, but the log shell was built probably in the 19th century.


